#### **Running of the matches**

#### **Match format:**

International qualifications:

2 sets in 6 games, 3rd set -> super tiebreak in 10 points

Main draw: Best of 3 sets with tie break in every set

Doubles and Jean BODIN Cup competitions:

2 sets in 6 games, with the 3rd set  $\rightarrow$  super tiebreak in 10 points, using the No-ad scoring.

#### **Courts:**

#### Welcome

#### Food and accomodation

Each foreign delegation will be housed in town: In one room, accommodating 2 to 4 individuals. For each team, an individual room will be provided for the coaching team.

Breakfast will be served on site, while all other meals will be provided at the club.

#### **Expenses**

All expenses paid for the official team of 4 players and 1 coach only until the last player of the team is eliminated.

Each extra player will be charged for accomodation based on fullboard (660 per day).

#### **Transport**

Shuttles will be arranged upon request:

- At the train stations in Poitiers or Angers
- At the airports of Nantes or Poitiers

#### Return fare of €40.

All transportation between accommodations, training venues, and competition sites will be provided by the organization at no cost.
