Running of the tournament

International Qualifications : October 17 and 18

A draw of 32 participants comprising 4 Wild Cards and 28 players (including a maximum of 12 French competitors)

8 Advance to the Main Draw

Main draw : October 19 to October 24

A draw of 48 players comprising 8 qualified participants, 6 wild cards, 2 special entries, and 32 additional players, including 14 from France.

Jean BODIN Cup : For participants eliminated in the initial round of the main draw (both boys and girls).

Doubles Main Draw : Registration with the referee on Monday, October 19, prior to 12 p.m.

Running of the matches

Match format:

International qualifications :

2 sets in 6 games, 3rd set → super tiebreak in 10 points
Using the No-let service

Main draw : Best of 3 sets with tie break in every set

Using the No-let service

Doubles : 2 sets in 6 games, with the 3rd set → super tiebreak in 10 points,
using the No-ad scoring and the No-let service

Jean BODIN Cup (consolation) : 2 sets in 4 games with a 2 games lead required,
with the 3rd set → super tiebreak in 10 points,
using the No-ad scoring and the No-let service

Courts :

The tournament is scheduled to take place on :

- 5 new indoor resin courts at the Bressuire Tennis Club.
- 1 indoor resin court + 4 outdoor synthetic clay courts designed for warm-up.

Balls :

Official **TRETORN** tennis balls

Four new balls provided per match. Ball changes are permitted only from the semi-finals of the singles onwards.

Consolation: 4 used balls

Food and accomodation

Each foreign delegation will be housed in town :
In one room, accommodating 2 to 4 individuals.
For each team, an individual room will be provided for the coaching team.

Breakfast will be served on site, while all other meals will be provided at the club.

Expenses

All expenses paid for the national squad of **4 players and 1 coach only** until the last player of the team is eliminated.

Each extra player will be charged for accomodation based on fullboard (**€60** per day).

Transport

Shuttles will be arranged upon request:

- At the train stations in Poitiers or Angers
- At the airports of Nantes or Poitiers

Return fare of €40 per vehicle

All transportation between accommodations, training venues, and competition sites will be provided by the organization at no cost.

Medical unit

Each day, a doctor and an on-site physiotherapist will be available for consultation during the tournament.
